

Dear PCS Families,

PCS is participating in an exciting program that encourages children in grades K-6 to read for fun. *Read to Succeed* is a free program from Six Flags® and Discovery Education. Every student who completes six hours of recreational reading before **February 24, 2012** is eligible for a free admission ticket valid at participating Six Flags theme parks. Students will develop a greater appreciation for books when they see that you think reading is important too. You're sure to have fun as you investigate the world of reading together!

Here's what you need to know:

- Only students in grades K-6 are eligible to take part in the Reading Club
- Review the attached reading log. You should use this sheet to record what and how long your child reads
- Your child must complete six hours, or 360 minutes, of recreational reading. Please initial each entry and then sign the reading log to verify that the six hours of reading have been completed
- Your child can read books, magazines, newspapers, or comic books. What doesn't count is any reading your child must do for homework or a class assignment. Kids can read silently, aloud, or with an adult—you can read to your child, or your child can read to you
- Remind your child to return the reading log to his/her teacher by **February 24**—late entries will not be accepted

About the Tickets

Tickets will be distributed to students by *Succeed to Read* coordinator Tracy Rothman. The ticket is valid for admission on select dates during the 2012 season. Dates will be included on the tickets. Tickets are valid for students in grades K-6 only and are not valid for anyone over the age of 13. No exceptions. Each ticket is valid for one free admission only. Tickets are not for resale and are nontransferable. They cannot be replaced if lost, stolen, or damaged.
